

How to Download Data Files from the Online System

To view District Data Files


- *For division-level users
- 1. From the Division Home Page, select Download Data Files.



2. Select Download Fall/MidYear/Spring Data Files.



3. On the right-hand side, choose the school year for which you want to view files. The current school year will automatically show up. If you want to view files for a past school year, click on the drop-down menu and select the appropriate year.






4. Click the assessment window (Fall, Mid-Year, or Spring) next to the grade level for which you want to download data. The file will automatically download as a .csv file and contain the student demographic and score data. This file will include all schools in the district that are open and had scores entered into the online system during this assessment window. Scores entered using Late Score Entry do not appear in the files.

- *For both school-level users and division-level users
- 1. Select Download Data Files.




2. On the right-hand side, choose the school year for which you want to view files. The current school year will automatically show up. If you want to view files for a past school year, click on the drop-down menu and select the appropriate year.





3. Click the assessment window (Fall, Mid-Year, or Spring) next to the grade level for which you want to download data. This file will include all teachers in the school that entered scores into the online system during the selected assessment window. Scores entered using Late Score Entry do not appear in data files.
