



# Blind Pick

Skill: Alphabet Recognition

<u>What you need</u>	<u>Who can play</u>
A large sheet of paper Markers of pens	Child and adult / older sibling

## What you do

1. On the sheet of paper, write letters all over in random order.
2. Hang the paper at a height within reach of your child.
3. Cover the eyes of your child and ask him/her to put a finger anywhere on the paper (similar to Pin the Tail on the Donkey).
4. Have your child open his/her eyes and tell you the letter s/he picked.

## Other ways to play

1. Have the adult or older sibling be the one to choose a letter.
2. Use magnetic letters on a magnetic surface.
3. Write the letters on a sidewalk and have the child stand on or jump to a letter.

## Taking it further

Have your child say....

- a. ... the sound of the letter.
- b. ... words that start with the letter's sound.
- c. ... words that end with the letter's sound.
- d. ... words that have the letter's sound in the middle.
