



# Letter Hunt

Skill: Letter Sounds

| <u>What you need</u>  | <u>Who can play</u>             |
|---|---------------------------------|
| Alphabet cards (cards with one letter written on each card) | Child and adult / older sibling |

## What you do

1. Hide some or all of the alphabet cards around the room or several rooms.
2. Invite your child to find a card and bring it to you.
3. Have your child identify the name of the letter and the sound the letter makes. For example, “This is “b” and it makes the sound /b/.”
4. Invite your child to hide their letters around the room and repeat the activity, either with the same or different letters.

## Other ways to play

1. Lay all or several of the cards out on a table or floor. Make the sound of one of the letters, and have your child hunt for the letter that makes that sound.
2. Have your child hide the letters, you go and hunt for them, and when you find them, have your child make the sound of each letter.

## Taking it further

1. Have your child find a card and then tell you the name and sound of the letter and a word that starts with that letter.
2. Have your child find an object in your home that starts with each letter that they find.
