



# Rhyme Chime

Skill: Rhyme



<u>What you need</u>	<u>Who can play</u>
Printed copy of rhyming pictures (attached) <i>Note: Use these same pictures for Squirrel in a Tree and Go Fish!</i>	Child and adult / older sibling

## What you do

1. Make a deck of rhyming cards by printing and cutting apart the attached pictures.
2. Shuffle the cards. Hold up two of the cards and say:  
Rhyme Chime! Now it's time!  
Tell me, (your child's name), do these rhyme?  
Then name the two pictures.
3. If your child gives the correct answer, and the cards do rhyme, give them the cards. If they are incorrect, or the cards do not rhyme, keep the cards and continue playing.
4. Continue until all cards have been matched, and your child has answered correctly for each pair.

## Other ways to play

Make a pile of one of each rhyming pair of pictures. Spread the other cards out on the table. Hold up a card from the pile and say:

Rhyme Chime! Now it's time!

Tell me, (your child's name), can you find the rhyme?"

Have your child find the card that rhymes with the one you are holding up.

## Taking it further

Shuffle the cards. Hold up one of them and say:

Rhyme Chime! Now it's time!

Tell me, (your child's name), can you make a rhyme?

Have your child name a word that rhymes with that picture.
